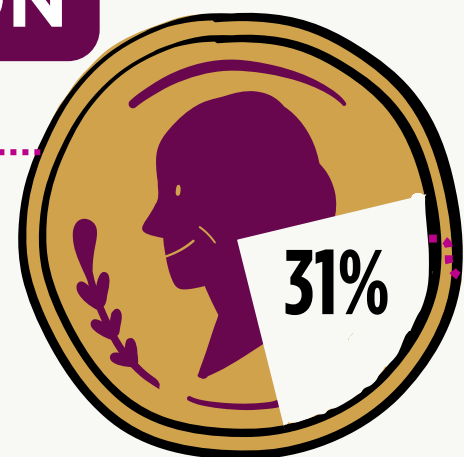

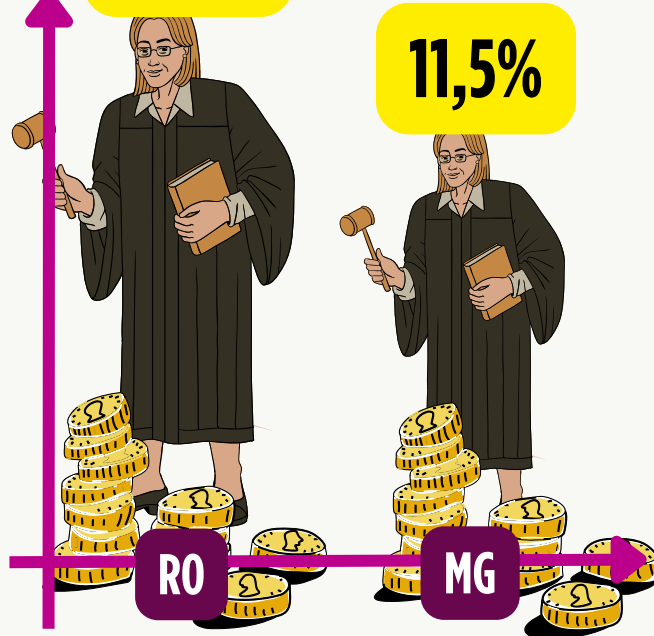
Other Current and Investment Expenses

PERCENTAGE OF THE TOTAL STATE BUDGET ALLOCATED TO THE JUSTICE SYSTEM

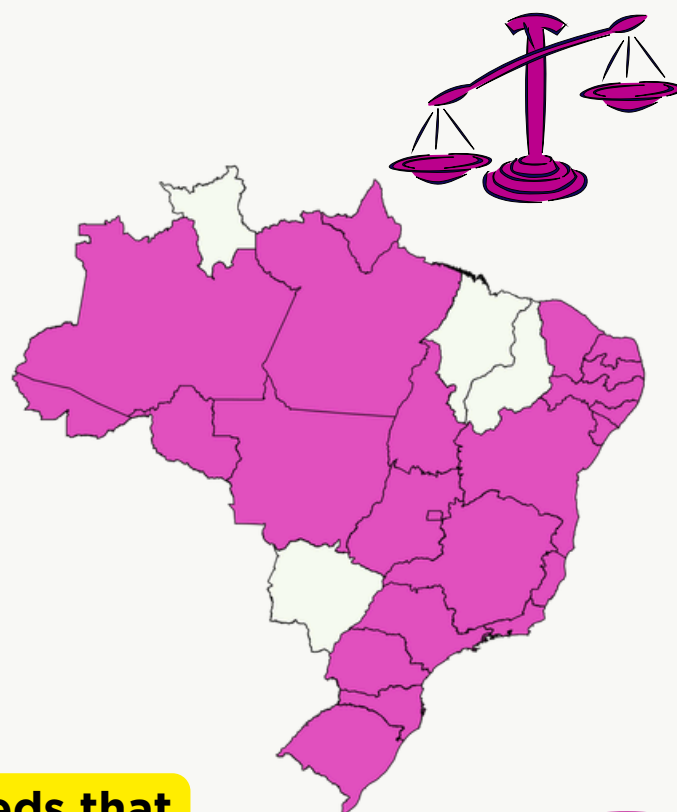

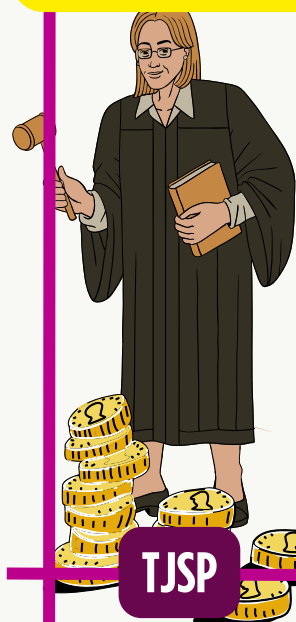
São Paulo (USD 3.6 billion) and Minas Gerais (USD 2.4 billion) are the states with the highest absolute spending

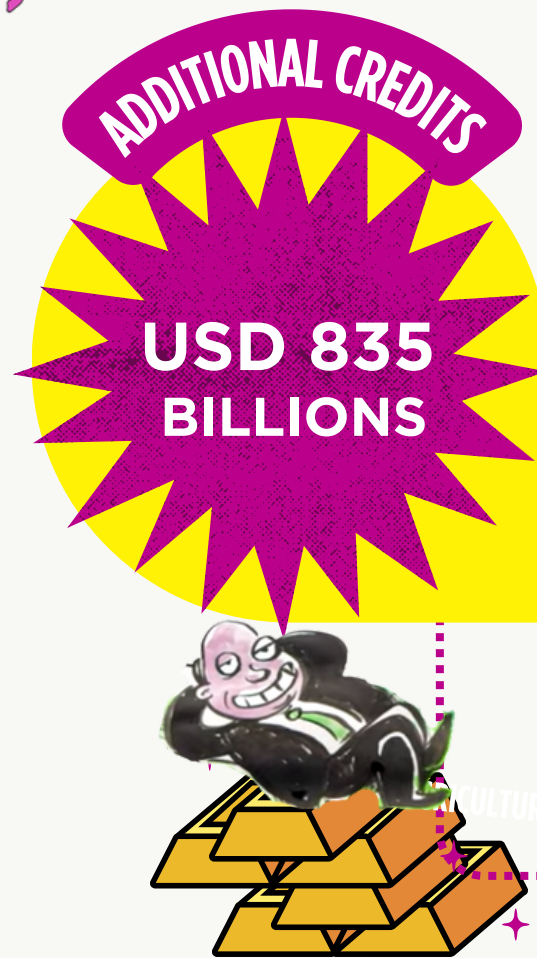


Governments have been distributing more money than planned, without going through the legislative assemblies
